Sub: IMPROVEMENT IN RESULTS – FOCUSSED MONITORING

Madam/Sir,

Please recall the details discussion held during one day Principals' meeting held on 04.09.2017 regarding results of board classes. Analysis of results for Class XII revealed that dismal performance of few KVs viz. – Ambikapur, No.2 Korba (NTPC), Jagdalpur & Dhamtari and few KVs where pass percentage was below regional pass percentage viz. – Dantewada, Dhamtari, Kanker, No.4 Korba, Durg, Mahasamund, Manendragarh & Raigarh has largely resulted in decrease in the overall pass % of the Region.

Furthermore, subjectwise analysis reveals maximum number of failures in Economics (91) followed by Maths (51) but very disheartening to note that there are failures in other subject also – B.St. (40), Accountancy (24), Chemistry (17), Biology (14), Phy. Edu.(07), Physics (06), English (06), C.S. (03), & Hindi (03) which could very well have been avoided.

Now that only 03 months approximate time is left before the commencement of Board Exams, you must have made an action plan for achieving the 100% pass target. It is high time that an all-out efforts is made including extra classes, remedial classes, short tests, slip tests etc. Few strategies to be adopted are enlisted below :-

STRATEGIES TO BE ADOPTED :-

- Identify the students who are not performing upto the expectations, their number should not be more than 10 per section. Ensure their attendance in school.
- Ensure that Principal personally have regular interaction with the parents of such students.
- Ensure that syllabus coverage by teachers is completed by 15th November 2017 (teachers should be instructed to take extra classes, if not completed).
- Remaining time of the month of November 2017 be utilised for revision.
- Blue print of the Question Paper to be discussed by the teachers alongwith sample Question Papers and Marking Scheme.
- Sufficient number of set of sample Question Papers be made available to the students (chapterwise).
- To instruct teachers that such identified students be told of simple comparatively easier topics that they prepare first thoroughly.


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- Also the topics/ units carrying higher weightage of marks cannot be ignored so the students may be drilled in most often asked questions in previous years from these units.
- As we all know from experience that students do not have sufficient writing practice, this is to be ensured.
- Sufficient practice of Study material that has been received in school.

Once the syllabus is completed, teachers has to keep teaching / Explanation to the minimum and mark children write instead (with or without book).

Many of the students have missed regular classes due to participation in Sports and other activities, their academic loss has to be compensated by organizing extra classes.
