**MESSAGE TO ALL STAKE HOLDERS**

Dear stake holders beware of fake offers by calls/SMS/E-mail/social media asking money promising favors from KVS. As a stakeholder always tread the path of sincerity and follow the Rule of Law. Do not fall prey to fake promises by unscrupulous elements that will tempt you on to the path of corruption and deceit.

As employees of the Vidyalaya be ever vigilant! Tread with caution that you may not deliberately or inadvertently accept or give favors which may morally compromise your status as a teacher or staff.

As Principal of the Vidyalaya, never bypass rules and regulations to expedite matters however imperative it may be to find quick solutions for impending problems. When rules are bypassed and solutions found, they themselves will become problems tomorrow. So be vigilant!

As in-charge Examination, always be watchful, lest the examination procedure lose its sanctity. Never compromise on any Examination protocol, for on the quality of conduct of Examination rests the quality of tomorrow's young generation.

As setters of question papers be meticulous in your work. Maintain the highest degree of confidentiality. Be aware of your responsibility that you are holding the future of your students in the palms of your hands and show total commitment to this solemn responsibility.

As incumbent teachers on contract in a Vidyalaya, ensure that you are wise to the contract you are signing with this institution regarding your duties, responsibilities and emoluments. Be informed that the clauses of contract are uniform in all Vidyalayas. So are the procedures for advertisements, interviews, selection and appointment. Do not offer bribes to anyone it be a KVS Staff at any level or an outsider who may promise to ease the way to appointment. To offer a bribe is a crime as also accepting one.

As parents seeking admission in KVS be sharp to read the rules of admission, understand it is a very transparent procedure, trust only your own self and do not be gullible to people who promise to get your wards admissions.

As students have the moral courage to speak out when you have been victimized or have been a witness to an act of bullying, brutality, betrayal, harassment of any kind from any level of the system.

As suppliers and vendors to the Vidyalaya do not offer bribes or compromise on the quality of goods and services offered. Be vigilant and report any such matters if such demand is made of you.

Whichever stakeholder you are, be informed that KVS will never ask you to furnish confidential matters through your personal e-mail account, SMS or through social media. If any such request comes to you

make sure you report the matter to the relevant higher authority for it will not be a query with Bonafide intent.

If every stakeholder has the right to be in an upright and honest system, it can happen only if every person performs the duty to be vigilant. The rot of any system begins from within never from outside. So if one wishes the system to be transparent and incorruptible it will happen only if every stakeholder is vigilant that he/she is not the seed of the rot! Be the change which you wish to see!
